

Some conclusions from the consultation

Swedish Agency for Marine and Water Management

- Common definitions of trade, services and trade in services can be used when defining and analyzing trade in fisheries services.
 - Fisheries and aquaculture services are intangible products provided to or on behalf on another person or entity in respect of the fisheries and aquaculture sectors, including as part of pre-harvesting, extraction/harvesting and post-harvesting activities
- Harvesting under an access agreement constitutes a fishing service when:
 - The fish resources are owned by the costal state
 - The harvested fish is landed for the benefit of the costal state

Fairness for developing countries



- Trade in services increases globally
- Trade in services provides both opportunities and risks for developing countries.
- Risks need to be mitigated

Recommendations to COFI

- That FAO sekr. develops a methodology for increasing its knowledge base,
- Include trade in fisheries services in the biennial Questionnaire on the CCRF
- Best-practice review

- Next step in the process could be:
 - Technical consultation negotiating international guidelines
 - Technical guidelines developed by the secretariat
 - Something innovative???
