

- Regional programmes: PEUMP (45M EUR), PESCAO (15M EUR), ECOFISH (28M EUR)
- AOTTP (13,6M EUR)
- National programmes: Mali, Mauritania, Ghana, Liberia, Uganda, Somalia, Cambodia, Myanmar, Thailand, Vietnam, PNG

Very different in size, scope and approaches ++ Cooperation with EU Member States State of play (2018) Today: 386M EUR

New fisheries and aquaculture programmes (1)

- Support to African Union (12M EUR) follow up of FISHGOV
 - Positive outcomes (coordination / PFRS and networks)
 - Limits: lack of focus, limited synergies with other AU initiatives, limited policy dialogue
 - New programme

More focused / added value of a continental approach Should take into account AU institutional reform Managed by EUD in Addis Ababa



New fisheries and aquaculture programmes (2)

- FISH4ACP (40M EUR)
 - Will follow a VCA approach
 - / solid VC analyses covering economic, social and environnemental aspects (inspired of VCA4D)
 - FAO to develop a common methodology
 - Call for manifestation of interest launched in April

 71 proposals, some 40 countries, both fisheries
 and aquaculture VC
 - Final selection in Autumn, start of activities in January 2020
